BEACH BARBECUES

A designated BBQ zone (west of Sandbanks promenade) provides a safe area for preparing & cooking BBQ food.

If 12 people or fewer wish to hold a BBQ then they may do so at any time before 6.00pm but only at the designated area west of Sandbanks promenade. After 6.00pm they may use other areas of the beach.

Where 13 or more people wish to get together for a beach party or BBQ they are required to give the Council seven days prior notice¹. Groups are limited to a maximum of 80 people.

BBQ TERMS & CONDITIONS

- ❖ No party BBQ should start before 6.00pm and it must have ended by 11.00pm.
- ❖ Large party BBQs must take place in the designated area at Sandbanks – not on the promenade, patio areas, beach hut patio areas, balcony areas, hard-standing areas or sand patios. We cannot guarantee that your party will have exclusive use of the designated area.
- ❖ Please keep noise to a minimum. Remember, this is also a residential area.
- ❖ No open fires! Due to the fire risk & regulations no open fires are permitted on any open space in Poole, including the beaches.
- ❖ Only plastic drinking glasses permitted on the beach & promenade. Glass bottles must be disposed of in the waste bins – not in the sand or on the promenade.
- ❖ No flashing or laser lights. You are on the shoreline – the use of flashing or laser lights can be a hazard to boats on the open water.
- ❖ There must be no financial transactions carried out in relation to the BBQ activity, e.g. payment for food or drinks by the general public.
- ❖ The promenade cannot be used for access, unloading of equipment or parking of vehicles.
- ❖ Car parking charges as posted will apply if using any Council car park whilst attending any event, BBQ or private function.
- ❖ Please leave the site in a clean & tidy condition. All litter and rubbish must be either removed or deposited in nearby waste bins. *Please remember to recycle your plastic, glass & paper where possible & appropriate.*
- ❖ Please do not bury rubbish in the sand where it may cause a health & safety hazard to other beach users.
- ❖ Leave used portable BBQs on the promenade or sea wall for collection by our beach cleaners. Please do not bury them in the sand where they cause problems for beach cleaning machinery. Do not put hot ashes in the waste bins.
- ❖ Please give proper consideration and respect to all other beach users.
- ❖ Enforcement officers will be carrying out routine checks.
