



# APPLICATION FOR PART TIME WORKERS PARKING PERMITS

The Transportation and Technical Services Committee of the Council has considered a request to introduce a facility to enable part-time workers to purchase parking permits, as they cannot benefit from the current 7-day season tickets. It has been decided that the scheme will operate in the Swimming Pool Car Park (adjacent to the Dolphin Swimming Pool). Further details of the scheme are set out below: -

- Parking permits are sold in batches of five 5-hour sessions. The cost is based on £100.00 for fifty, 5-hour sessions (i.e. 10 batches). Individual batches are therefore sold at £10.00 each.
- The parking period allowed for each session is five hours. However, if two permits are validated for the same day, vehicles can be left for 10 hours. i.e. on arriving scratch off the month, date, year and time showing the time of arrival and then validate a second permit, but scratching off an arrival time of 5 hours later than the first permit.
- Parking permits will be issued to allow such parking. The driver must validate the parking permit on arrival at the car park showing the vehicle registration number, with the month, date, year and time of arrival in the car park scratched off.

In order that a parking permit may be issued, please complete the details overleaf and send this form to the address above, with your remittance. Cheques should be made payable to "Borough of Poole".

## CONDITIONS OF USE

- The purchase of a parking permit is only valid for the car park for which it was purchased.
- The parking permit does not guarantee a parking space.
- If a parking permit has been altered or tampered with, then a Penalty Charge Notice will be issued to the vehicle displaying the parking permit.
- The driver must ensure that the parking permit is clearly visible to the Council's Parking Attendant's who inspect the car park. **If a Penalty Charge Notice is issued, it will not be cancelled on production of the parking permit.**
- The council reserves the right to withdraw any parking permits found to have been improperly issued or used.
